NY RISING RENTAL PROPERTIES PROGRAM ASBESTOS ABATEMENT REIMBURSEMENT FORM

Revised: February 29, 2016

Instructions: This form is to be completed by the applicant and returned to review@recreatenys.org only if your asbestos hazard has already been resolved.

In order to be reimbursed for lead remediation, qualifying applicants must return a signed copy of this form along with the following documentation:

1. The name and license number of the firm who conducted the abatement work (include copy of New York State license);
2. The name(s) and certificate number(s) of the individual project Supervisor(s) and Asbestos Handler(s) who conducted the abatement work (include copy of New York State certificate);
3. Copies of Project Notifications to New York State Department of Labor and United States Environmental Protection Agency, if applicable;
4. The name and license number of the firm who conducted the independent air testing and contractor monitoring (include copy of New York State license);
5. The name(s) and certificate number(s) of the individual Project Monitor(s) and/or Air Sampling Technician(s) who conducted the independent air testing and contractor monitoring (include copy of New York State certificate);
6. The name of the laboratory that analyzed air samples and its New York State Department of Health Environmental Laboratory Approval Program (ELAP) number, if applicable;
7. Copies of the waste manifest(s) that verifies waste generated by the remediation work was properly transported and disposed of at a landfilled permitted to receive asbestos waste;
8. Copies of waste transporter's licenses; and
9. Copy of paid invoice from licensed contractor.

I certify through a signed copy of this form that a New York State Department of Labor-licensed Asbestos Abatement Contractor Firm and an independent New York State Department of Labor-licensed Asbestos Project Air Sampling Firm were hired to perform the required asbestos abatement work according to the New York State Department of Labor's *Rule 56 Asbestos* found at 12 N.Y.C.R.R. Part 56.
