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# NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION BULK STORAGE SITES

## INTRODUCTION

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) Bulk Storage Program Database identified aboveground storage tanks found within 1 mile of each project component site. NYSDEC described the tank sites as chemical, Major Oil Storage Facility, or petroleum tanks. Information on tank location, permits, and current use is provided. Note that some sites may have more than one tank, and tanks may overlap between components.

## SMITH POND REHABILITATION COMPONENT

An emergency generator would be installed in an existing alcove area on the rear property of the East Rockaway High School in close proximity to the existing interior electrical room and adjacent to an existing generator that provides power to the school sump pump system. The 350 KW generator for East Rockaway High School would have be equipped with a 1,024 gallon diesel fuel sub-based tank capable of providing power to the school building for 24-36 hours.
