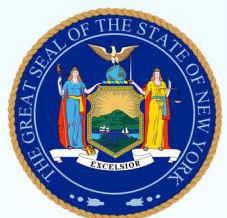

Hello Kate,

Thank you for your request for consultation. I am confirming HUD's receipt of the request and that you have fulfilled your obligation under requirements of the National Disaster Resilience Competition NOFA. We will forward this request and any subsequent materials to SRIRC, but no further action under the NOFA is required. We will keep record of your request, but you may submit documentation of submission to the Regional Coordination Working Group as an attachment to your application and it will not be counted toward page limits in the application.

For additional information, please note the following FAQ guidance to be included in the next posted Phase 2 FAQ document:

Q: What is the required content of Covered project submissions sent to SRIRC?

A: The NOFA does not specify the content of submissions to the SRIRC. HUD recommends, but does not require, that applicants should submit information with sufficient detail to receive meaningful feedback. Although not required, applicants subject to the November 18, 2013, Federal Register Notice may submit information responsive to paragraphs VI.2.c. through VI.2.f. (78 FR 69107), and paragraphs VI.2.g.(2) through (5) (78 FR 69108), of the November 18, 2013 Notice, along with a project description to the SRIRC to the extent applicable, and to the extent that the information will facilitate consultation with the SRIRC and the goal of promoting a regional and cross-jurisdictional approach to resilience. The SRIRC may separately provide guidance to applicants regarding the level of detail in the submission necessary to receive feedback, but any guidance from the SRIRC is not a requirement of the NOFA.

Прощению не подлежит

В пятницу, 2 октября, несмотря на приближающуюся субботу, тысячи людей пришли проститься с убитыми накануне жителями поселения Нерия Эйтамом и Наамой Хенкиными

На похороны молодой супружеской пары прибыли президент Реувен Ривлин и множество политиков от оппозиции и коалиции. Звучали подходящие случаю речи, раздавались призывы к возмездии и основанию в их память нового еврейского поселения. Когда 9-летний сын Хенкиных начал читать кадиш по 30-летним родителям, все смолкло. Вечные слова еврейской поминальной молитвы звучали в абсолютной тишине. Ребенок, читающий молитвы над телами родителей, убитых зверями в человеческом обличье, - такое не забывается. И не прощается. Никогда.

Сегодня уже точно известно, что это было не спонтанное, а тщательно спланированное и осуществленное убийство. За его организацией стоял командир одной из действовавших в Шхеме ячеек ХАМАСа Раиб Ахмед Альяви (37), уже сидевший в прошлом в израильской тюрьме за террористическую деятельность. Это был далеко не первый теракт, осуществленный Альяви и его людьми, но до сих пор все они оставались безнаказанными.

Еще днем 1 октября три члена группировки, Карам Разак (23), Наиф Наджи Хамад (26) и Яхья Абдалла (33), проехали по дороге, ведущей от Итамара к Алфей-Менаше, и выбрали наиболее удобное для стрельбы место. Вечером Альяви отдал приказ о начале операции, и две машины двинулись в путь с целью убить как можно больше евреев.

В первой машине ехал Джамаль Амар - в его заднюю входило проверить, нет ли на дороге поблизости патруля ЦАХАЛа. За рулем второй сидел Самир Куса (33), рядом и на заднем сиденье расположились трое из тех, кому предстояло открыть огонь, - Разак, Абдалла и Хамад.

В заранее выбранном месте Куса выровнял свою машину с машиной Хенкиных и трое террористов начали стрельбу по водителю из пистолетов и винтовки М-16. Когда Эйтам Хенкин остановил машину, террористы тоже остановились и вышли, чтобы сначала произвестись с двух сторон контрольные выстрелы в Эйтама и Нааму Хенкиных, а затем убить их детей - Матана Гилеля (9), Ницана Ицхака (7), Нету Элизера (4) и восьмимесячного Итамара. Однако во время произведения контрольных выстрелов Яхья Абдалла неожиданно попал в руку Карам Разака. Тот взвыл от боли и выронил пистолет. Абдалла еще раз нажал на спуск, но его пистолет вдруг заклинило.

Это чудо и спасло жизнь детям Хенкиных - террористы поспешили ретироваться, оставив на месте убийства пистолет Разака. Последний был доставлен друзьями в шхемскую больницу и госпитализирован под именем Арам аль-Масри. Ответственность за теракт поначалу взяла на себя организация "Исламский джихад", хотя, повторим, он был осуществлен ячейкой ХАМАСа.

К чести ШАБАКа, его сотрудники не дали ввести себя в заблуждение ложным сообщением и почти сразу вышли на след убийц. В течение суток пятеро членов ячейки были арестованы и дали на допросах признательные показания. Еще через день бойцы подразделение "мистааравим" ("псевдоарабы") ворвались в больницу в Шхеме и вывели оттуда Карам Разак.

Чуть позже была найдена винтовка М-16, из которой бандиты расстреляли Нааму и Эйтаму Хенкиных.

Вероятно, вскоре против всех шестерых террористов будет выдвинуто обвинительное заключение и они предстанут перед судом. А дальше, видимо, убийцы будут ждать очередного жеста доброй воли со стороны Израиля.

Многие из пришедших на похороны хорошо знали и любили Эйтама и Нааму Хенкиных. Эйтам, отнюдь не недавний репатриант из США, был набирающим известность в кругах религиозных сионистов писателем и журналистом, готовил к изданию первую книгу, а Наама возглавляла популярную в этих же кругах компанию, предлагавшую услуги дизайнера и компьютерной графики. Эйтам и Наама поженились совсем юными. По воспоминаниям соседей, они были неразлучны и все свободное время уделяли воспитанию детей. И хотя сейчас дети Хенкиных находятся в заботливых руках близких, понятно, что родителей им не заменит никто.

Убийство супругов Хенкиных, судя по всему, потрясло не только Израиль, но и весь мир. Свои соболезнования в связи с этим злодеянием поспешили выразить президент Барак Обама и его канцелярия, генсек ООН Пан Ги Мун и глава внешнеполитического ведомства ЕС Федерика Могерини. Но к словам сочувствия они присовокупили дежурные призывы к сдержанности, адресованные обеим сторонам. Между тем, от лидера ПА Абу-Мазена ни соболезнования, ни осуждения теракта не последовало, напротив, он разразился восхитением "шахидами", а ХАМАС и "Исламский джихад", как и ожидалось, произвели убийц в герои.

Все это было воспринято на палестинской улице однозначно как одобрение убийства евреев и призыв к новым терактам. И они не заставили себя ждать.

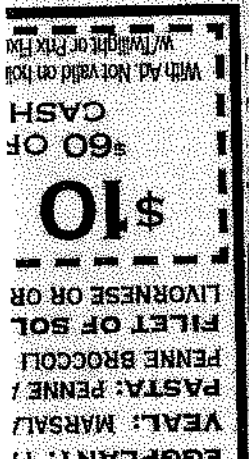

6. Responses to Public Comments

Summary of Outreach and Comments Received

The New York State Governor's Office of Storm Recovery (GOSR) committed to not only meeting—but to exceeding—the citizen participation requirements outlined in the NDRC NOFA. On October 6, 2015, GOSR kicked off a 15-day public comment period, prominently posting the State's Phase 2 NDRC application to GOSR's official homepage: www.stormrecovery.ny.gov. All required elements of the application were posted for review in English, as well as in Spanish, Russian, and Mandarin, the three most common use languages in the State based on an analysis of Census data for households with members five years or older with Limited English Proficiency. Copies of the application could also be requested without charge via info@stormrecovery.ny.gov; 1-855-NYS-SANDY; or TTY # 201-820-4004. GOSR accepted public comments by web, TTY, and mail at 64 Beaver Street, PO Box 230, New York, NY 10004, through Wednesday, October 21, 2015. The application was made accessible to persons with disabilities upon request by telephone or written request at the address above.

In addition, GOSR held three public hearings in strategic locations across the State to give all interested persons the opportunity to present oral and written comments on the State's Phase 2 NDRC application. The first was held on October 13, 2015, from 6 pm to 8 pm at the Empire State Plaza Convention Center in Albany, the State's capital, which is proximate to several Target Areas in the Upstate region. The second was held on October 14, 2015, from 6 pm to 8 pm at Freeport Village Hall in Freeport, Nassau County on Long Island. The third and final hearing was held on October 15, 2015, from 6 pm to 8 pm at 25 Beaver Street in Lower Manhattan.

The legal notices of these hearings and the comment period were heavily publicized in periodicals throughout the State, including the three main non-English newspapers, El Diario (Spanish), Russian Bazaar (Russian), and Epoch Times (Chinese), as well as AM New York, Newsday, Journal News, Oneida Daily Dispatch, Palladium Times, Press Republican, Staten Island Advance, Times Union, and the Leader Herald. The legal notices were also published in the Long Island Herald Papers including, Bellmore Herald Life, Franklin Square/Elmont Herald, Long Beach Herald, Lynbrook/East Rockaway Herald, Malverne/West Hempstead Herald, Merrick Herald Life, Nassau Herald, Oceanside Herald, Rockville Centre Herald, Rockaway Journal, South Shore Record, Valley Stream Herald, Freeport Leader, Wantagh Herald Citizen, Seaford Herald Citizen, and the Oyster Bay Guardian.

The State also sent electronic mailings about the public comment period and public hearings to key stakeholders, including community based organizations, local elected officials, NY Rising Community Reconstruction Program Planning Committee Members, and libraries.

During the public comment period, the State received one comment via the October 14, 2015, public hearing in Freeport, Long Island, and one comment in writing via the GOSR website.

1) Citizens Campaign for the Environment

Members of the Citizens Campaign for the Environment, a bi-state environmental public health organization with 80,000 members throughout New York and Connecticut, attend the public hearing to advocate on behalf of the Nassau County Outfall Pipe and Bay Resiliency Project

proposed in the State's Phase 2 NDRC application. They discussed research conducted by Stony Brook University whereby 85 percent of nitrogen abatements come from the current ocean outfall pipe. They stated that the nitrogen is feeding the wetlands causing them to have shallow roots, break apart easily, and therefore are less able to protect the mainland during storm surge. This worries the organization, especially because the wetlands do not only protect the mainland, but also are the nesting grounds for thousands of species. They expressed the overwhelming public support for the project and believe that if this project is approved, the wetlands and the bay will unequivocally recover.

Response: GOSR thanks the Citizens Campaign for the Environment for supporting the inclusion of the Nassau County Outfall Pipe and Bay Resiliency Project in the State's Phase 2 NDRC application. The State recognizes the importance of this project and appreciates the advocacy efforts and subject matter expertise provided by the organization to support this initiative.

2) Island Harvest Food Bank

Island Harvest Food Bank, a non-profit organization on Long Island, submitted a comment through the storm recovery website to propose the development of an Emergency Resource Center to ensure the availability of emergency supplies and access to food in the event of another disaster. They discussed the collaborative efforts of the organization, the financial commitments they have secured, and the scope of the organization--the largest hunger-relief organization on Long Island.

Response: GOSR thanks the Island Harvest Food Bank for their comment and proposal. In order to develop a competitive and compliant application, the State will not substantially amend its draft Phase 2 NDRC application to include this additional project proposal. However, the State commends the efforts of the Island Harvest Food Bank and their ongoing dedication to the health and wellbeing of Long Islanders.
