



Protect the Edge - Minimize rising water's entry into Breezy communities by strengthening the ocean and bay edges

Infrastructure - Strengthen power/utilities/communications/water management infrastructure to ensure sustainability and endurance at all times

Emergency Preparedness - Pursue measures to strengthen Breezy's ability to contend with and recover from large-scale natural disasters and emergency events

Housing - Rebuild and protect housing, the most important assets within the community


Economic Viability - Strengthen and protect commercial areas to protect and sustain economic health and vibrancy

Draft initial scope, approach, timing, potential funding, and other considerations for each project and recommendation

- Create detailed description of phases or key elements or outcomes
- Assess Timing
 - Short, Medium, Long-term
 - Can be multi-phase
- Assess other 'filters'
 - Feasibility (H/M/L)
 - Cost (H/M/L)
 - Risk Reduction (H/M/L)
- Assess potential funding
 - NYRCR funding
 - Other potential funding
- Document other considerations, dependencies, notes
