

1. Storm Impacts: What We've Heard

Ocean met the Bay

- Includes surge via access roads cutting through dunes
- 400 homes damaged or destroyed

Extensive Fires & Emergency Access Issues


- Materials, density of homes, and flooding cutting off firefighter access enabled spreading fire
- 126 homes destroyed and 22 damaged

Critical Infrastructure Impairment


- Loss of LIPA service
- Communication break-down

	Financial stability	7

	Strengthened emergency services	1

4. Short- & Long-Term Goals

Short-Term

- Strengthen emergency preparedness
- Improved coastal protection
- Elevate damaged/at-risk homes
- Support commercial recovery and redevelopment

Long-Term

- Become self-sufficient in emergencies
- Strengthen the edge (ocean and bay)
- Create sustainable drainage/water management systems
- Strengthen overall infrastructure and surface area
- Create consistent elevation
