



# Preliminary Needs and Opportunities: Infrastructure and Natural and Cultural Resources

---

## *Needs*

- Rebuilding and resiliency of community facilities: Athletic Club, Legion, Historical Society, etc.
- Increased access to energy sources
- Reduce Street flooding and sewer back-up

## *Opportunities*

- Significant wetland and park space
- Access to subway
