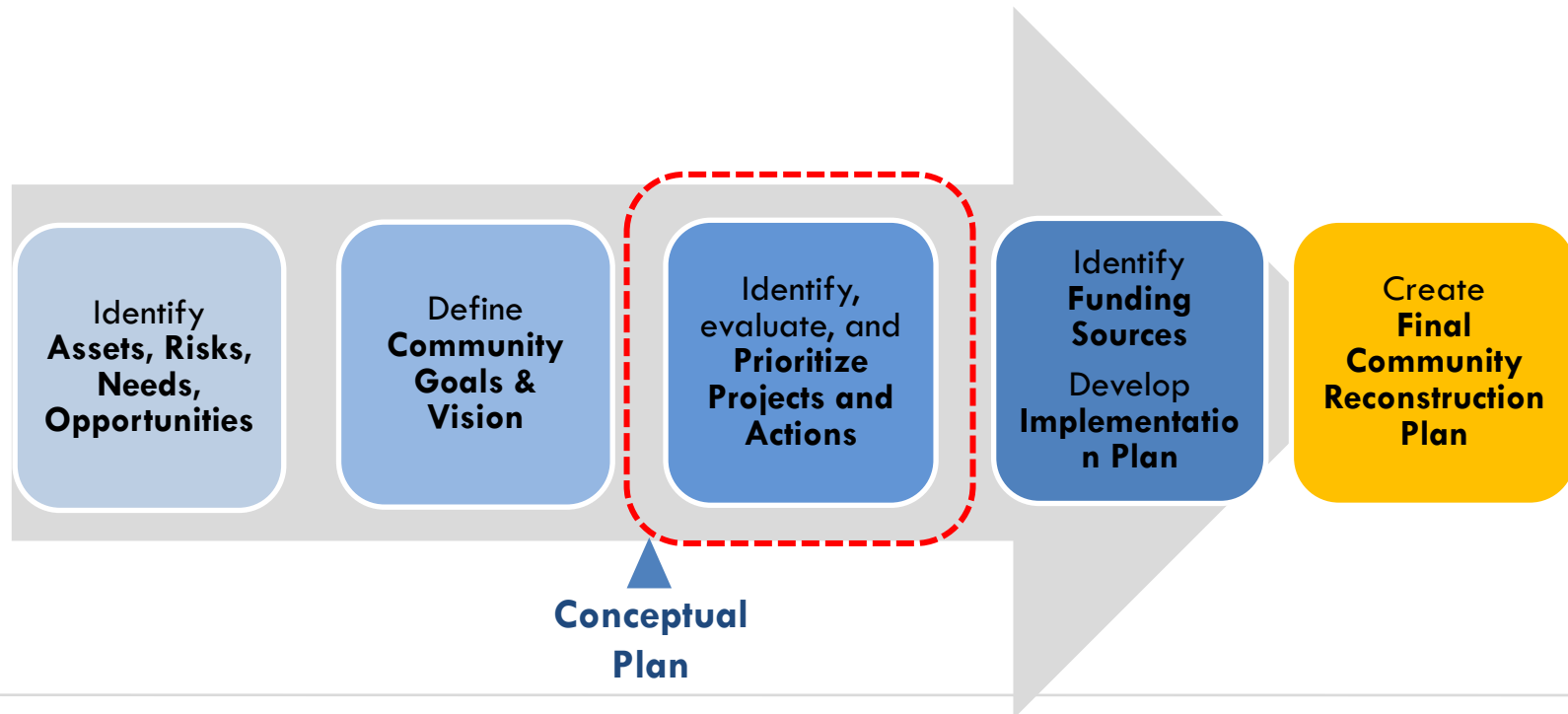

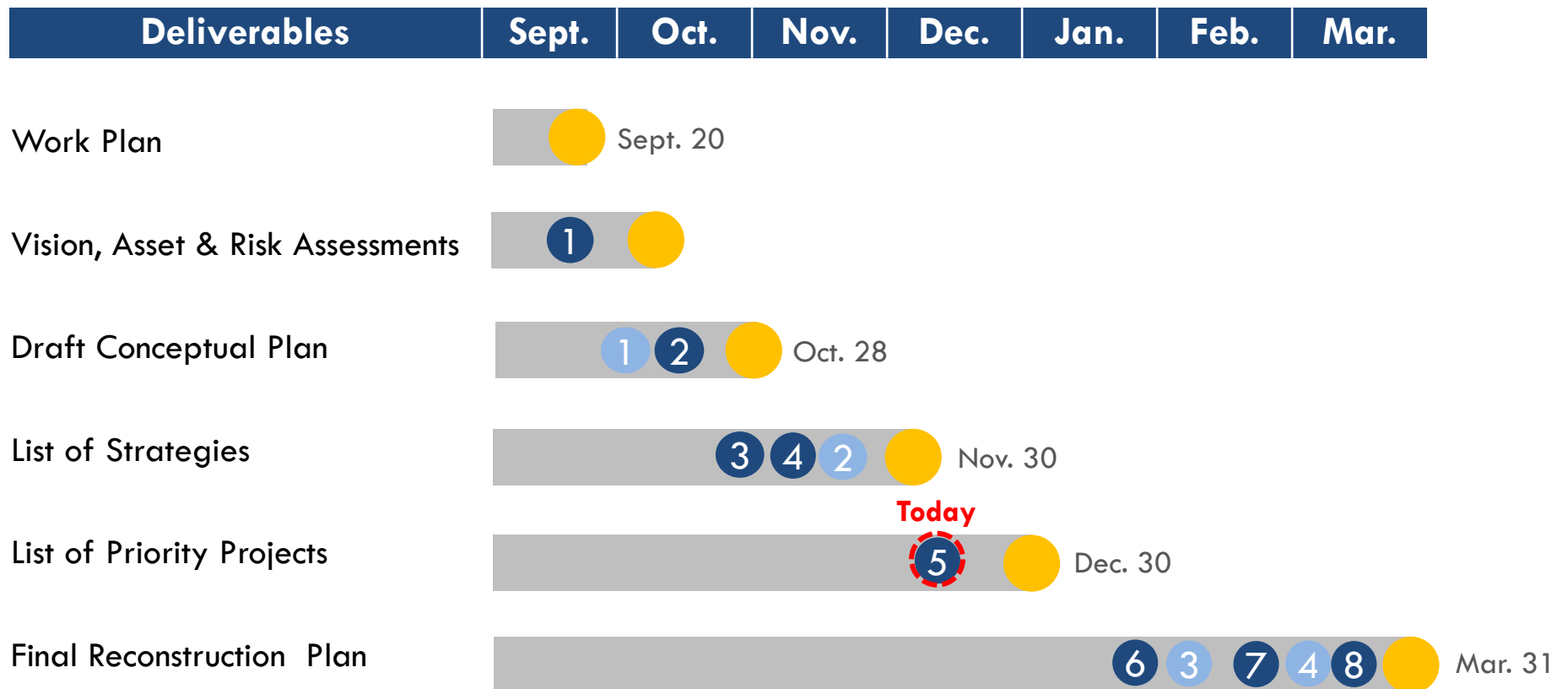

Rockaway East Strategies

Strengthen the Edge – Minimize entry of rising water into Rockaway East communities by strengthening the ocean and bay edges

Improve Utilities and Water Systems – Ensure reliability of electrical, drainage and wastewater systems during and after emergencies

Emergency Preparedness – Strengthen Rockaway East’s ability to contend with and recover from large-scale weather events

Expand Transportation – Improve and expand transportation for the communities across Rockaway East to ensure connectivity and multiple access redundancy

Promote Economic Resiliency – Strengthen key corridors and intersections to protect and sustain economic health during and after storms and to enhance community vibrancy

Expand Health and Social Services – Expand healthcare and social services, especially during and after emergencies

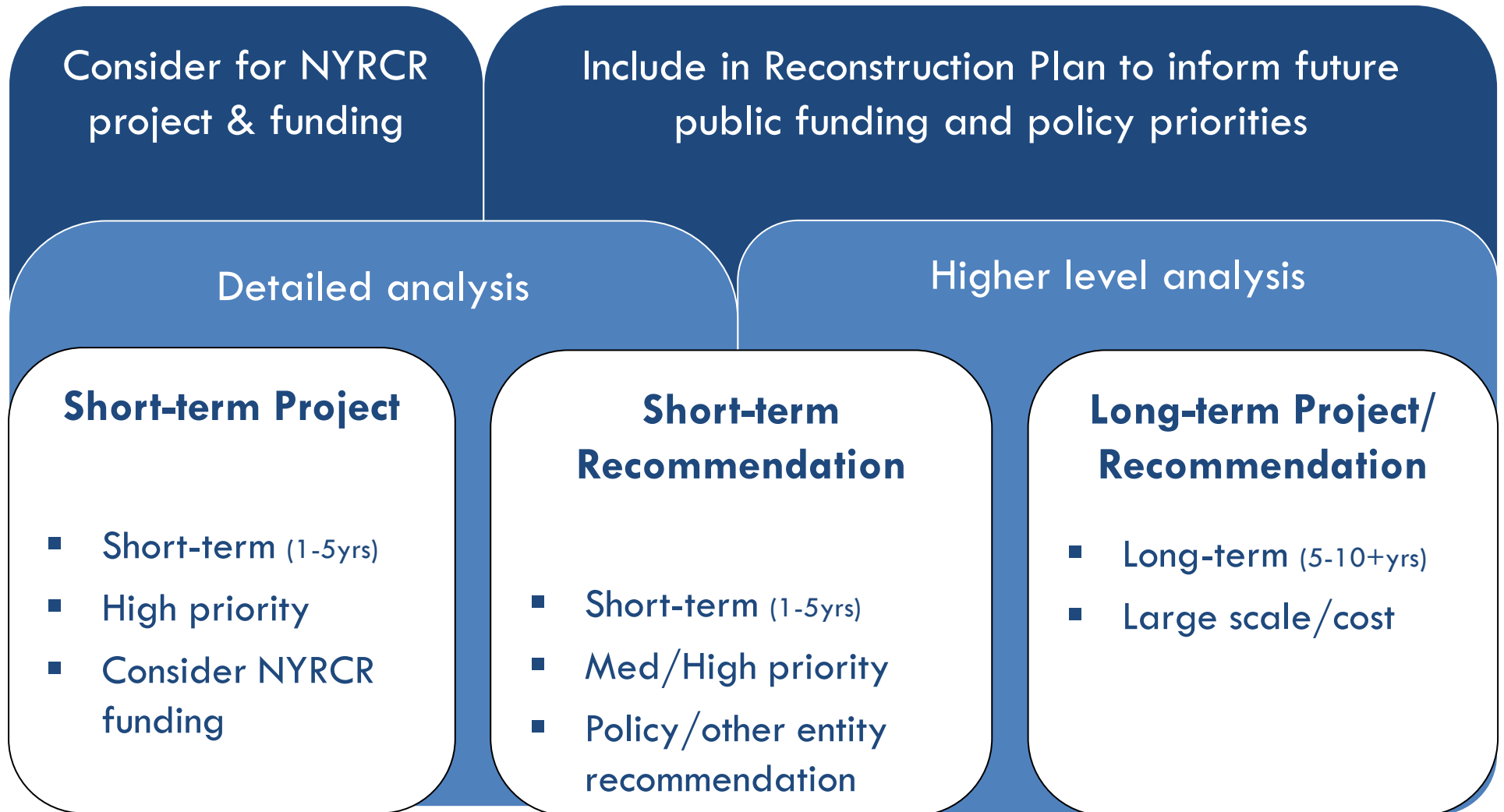

Draft initial scope, approach, timing, potential funding, and other considerations for each project and recommendation

1) Review Ideas and Best Practices

- Discuss initial ideas and talk through different approaches and considerations

2) Define Project/Recommendation

- Create detailed description of phases or key elements or outcomes
- Assess Timing
 - Short, Medium, Long-term
 - Can be multi-phase
- Assess other 'filters'
 - Feasibility (H/M/L)
 - Cost (H/M/L)
 - Risk Reduction (H/M/L)
- Assess potential funding, document other considerations, dependencies
