



Funding Sources

NY Rising Community Reconstruction Program Funds:

- The Rockaway West New York Rising Community was formed through agreement of planning committees:
 - Neponsit, Belle Harbor, Rockaway Park, Rockaway Beach

- Rockaway West will be eligible for CDBG-DR funding allocations up to \$21,315,516

- CDBG-DR funding is only one source of recovery funding
 - Communities are encouraged to think regionally and work collaboratively to leverage all funds potentially available

Select Funding Sources

NY Rising Community Reconstruction Program Funds:


- Eligible for up to \$21.3 million in CDBG-DR funding
- Possible additional funds for exemplary public engagement, regional coordination and design innovation

CDBG-DR is only one source of recovery funding.


Additional select funds:

- FEMA: Public & Individual Assistance, Hazard Mitigation Grants
- Social Services Block Grants
- Federal Transit Authority & Federal Highway Administration Relief
- Clean Water & Drinking Water State Revolving Fund
- NYC Build it Back (CDBG-DR)
- Small Business Matching Grant Program (CDBG-DR)
- NYC Nonprofit Recovery Loan/Grant Program






Rockaway West



Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM)


- V-zone (100-year floodplain and subject to wave action >3')

- 500-year floodplain (0.2% annual chance of flooding)




Inundation During Sandy



FEMA Preliminary Work Maps (June 2013)




NY State Risk Assessment Areas

MTA Ongoing Repair and Resiliency Improvements


- MTA has restored A and S train service




